Our state has asked parents of disabled children to provide unpaid skilled care, sometimes twenty-four hours a day, on top of parenting, working and other household duties every parent is familiar with all within a 24 hour day. Juggling all of these roles destabilizes the homes of disabled children in Oregon.

SB 1565 helps Oregon support disabled children and stabilizes their homes. SB 1565 will help the State of Oregon fulfill its promise to provide services for disabled residents in their communities.
