Bird Alliance of Oregon (formerly Portland Audubon) representing over 12,000 members across the state opposes HB 4106. Passage of this bill would undermine the state forest Habitat Conservation Plan by allowing unsustainable forestry practices that would continue to jeopardize water quality for hundreds of thousands of residents and would make it impossible to meet federal and state recovery goals for threatened and endangered species including commercially and recreationally important salmon, marbled murrelets, and the spotted owl. Please oppose HB 4106 and don't let this bill pass out of committee.
