Subject: Support for SB 1521 (-2) regarding the Acuity-Based Staffing Tool Requirements

On behalf of LeadingAge Oregon, we urge support for Senate Bill ("SB") 1521 and the -2 Amendment, which aims to clarify Acuity-Based Staffing Tool ("ABST") Requirements for Community-Based Care providers.

This bill clarifies when the Oregon Department of Human Services is obligated to put a condition on a facility's license due to insufficient staffing levels to meet both scheduled and unscheduled needs of residents. Additionally, it clarifies when the Department is authorized to apply other corrective actions.
