I strongly oppose the move to standard time. While I understand the desire to eliminate semi-annual clock changes, anything is preferable to permanent standard time. It is unconscionable that the legislature would ask people who work remotely with Eastern or Central Time zone companies or co-workers to suddenly wake up an hour earlier during the months of March-November while the rest of the country is on Daylight savings time. Oregon would be 4 hours behind EST for 8 months of the year, which is untenable.
