I strongly oppose Senate Bill 1538. It raises serious concerns for voters like me. While the intention behind translating candidate statements is to be inclusive, it may introduce confusion and increase costs. BUT the most important part of the bill is Section 3, Paragraph 2, lines 26 - 29. The removal of a repeat certification test for the vote tally system is worrisome, jeopardizing election security. This continues to undermine the integrity of our elections. This language MUST be removed!!

Also, reducing voter registration card opens the door to potential abuse. Shifting the financial estimate committee's term start seems unnecessary and disruptive. Any modifications to election procedures, even seemingly small, must undergo thorough scrutiny to uphold transparency and fairness in our democratic process.
