Small Donor Committee (SDC)	For statewide candidate: \$33,000 for each increment of 2,500 contributors. If SDC has 10,000 contributors, it can contribute--twice during the election year--\$132,000 .to any statewide candidate (total of \$264,000 to each candidate),  For other candidate, \$16,500 for each increment of 2,500 contributors. If SDC has 10,000 contributors, it can contribute--twice during the election year--\$66,000 to any other candidate (total of \$132,000 to each candidate),		\$10,000 per year	\$10,000 per year	\$5,000 per election (\$10,000 in the election year)	0	0
Membership Organization (501c4 or 501c5 only)	\$33,000 to statewide candidate per election = twice during election year  \$16,500 to other candidate per election = twice during election year  PLUS:  To any statewide candidate per year: 36 FTE months of "full-time staff equivalence," consisting of "direct voter contact, community organizing, community outreach and staff support." Example: Organization can hire 3 professional organizers, pay each one \$100,000 per year, and donate their full services to a statewide candidate for a year (value = \$300,000). If the candidate files in the year before the election year, this contribution can be made twice, equal to a value of \$600,000 to the candidate.  To any other candidate per year: 12 FTE months of "full-time staff equivalence," consisting of "direct voter contact, community organizing, community outreach and staff support." Example: Organization can hire 3 professional organizers, pay each one \$100,000 per year, and donate their full services to a non-statewide candidate for 4 months (value = \$100,000). If the candidate files in the year before the election year, this contribution can be made twice, equal to a value of \$200,000 to the candidate.  Anyone and any entity can create and fund an unlimited number of Membership Organizations, provided each has "authority to make independent decisions as to which candidates, if any, to support or oppose."
