Public Hearing

- HB 3341 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board for deposit in the Community Drinking Water Enhancement and Protection Fund.
- HB 3121 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to enter into a contract with the Oregon Association of Water Utilities to provide technical assistance, or enter into a contract with a third party to provide technical assistance, to address the needs and vulnerabilities of small and very small community water systems, construct and equip a water utility training center and employ three staff to provide related support and resources.
- HB 2988 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Instructs the Water Resources Department to take certain actions related to aquifer recharge and aquifer storage and recovery.
- HB 2950 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Land Conservation and Development Commission to update the statewide land use planning goal relating to "citizen involvement" by rule by June 30, 2027.

Work Session

- HB 2979 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to various entities for food production and distribution.
- HB 2984 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife out of the General Fund for deposit into the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.
- HB 3143 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Landowners Living with Beavers Grant Program Subaccount in the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.

- HB 3173 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the OregonFlora Program at Oregon State University.
- HB 3131 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, out of the General Fund, for deposit in the Oregon Agricultural Heritage Fund.
- HB 2805
Makes permanent the authority of the State Department of Agriculture to annually increase license fees for food establishments by up to three percent.
- HB 2806
Makes permanent the authority of the State Department of Agriculture to annually increase license fees for commercial weighing or measuring instruments by up to three percent, subject to certain maximum limits.
- HB 3010 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Oregon State University to develop a program for Spanish language pesticide education.
- HB 2809 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Increases the upper limit on pesticide registration fees.
- HB 2356
Adds lands to a metropolitan service district when those lands are within Metro's urban growth boundary and annexed by a city in Metro.
