Work Session

- HB 3341 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board for deposit in the Community Drinking Water Enhancement and Protection Fund.
- HB 3121 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to enter into a contract with the Oregon Association of Water Utilities to provide technical assistance, or enter into a contract with a third party to provide technical assistance, to address the needs and vulnerabilities of small and very small community water systems, construct and equip a water utility training center and employ three staff to provide related support and resources.
- HB 2813 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Harney Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Match Fund in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund.
- HB 3141
Designates October 12 of each year as Oregon Farmer and Rancher Day.
- HB 2558
Modifies the definition of "charter guide" for purposes of outfitter and guide laws.

Public Hearing

- HB 3502
Makes permanent certain provisions related to water right examiner certification.
- HB 3346
Requires the Department of Land Conservation and Development to study siting of energy facilities in designated critical ground water areas.
- HB 3486
Requires at least one member of the Research Vessel Council to be a trained scientist from the University of Oregon.

HB 3103 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Forester to establish sustainable harvest levels for harvesting timber on state forestland and develop a timber inventory model to inform sustainable harvest levels.
