#### **Work Session**

HB 2170

Authorizes the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, the State Marine Board or the State Department of Agriculture to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with a local government or a local service district to perform aquatic invasive species inspections at check stations.

HB 2982

Increases boating fees and deposits moneys into the Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Fund.

Establishes state policy on water reuse.

HB 2947 \*\*

Directs the Oregon State University Extension Service and the College of Agricultural Sciences of Oregon State University to study the distribution and occurrence of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) found in biosolids applied to agricultural fields that do not produce crops intended for human consumption.

HB 3114 \*\*

Instructs Oregon Consensus at Portland State University and Oregon State University to support a process related to water management in the Chewaucan River watershed.

HB 3856 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Imposes additional personal income tax.
