HB 2978 A

Makes certain changes concerning a program to reduce wildlife-vehicle collisions.

HB 2977 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Increases the state transient lodging tax.

HB 3856 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Imposes additional personal income tax.

HB 3010 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon State University to develop a program for Spanish language pesticide education.

HB 2408

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for allocation to Oregon State University to fund the agricultural experiment station and branch stations, the Oregon State University Extension Service and the Forest Research Laboratory.

HB 2342 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases certain wildlife license, tag and permit fee amounts.

HB 3314 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to Oregon State University for harmful algal bloom mitigation.

HB 3486

Requires at least one member of the Research Vessel Council to be a trained scientist from the University of Oregon.

HB 3487

Authorizes counties that receive moneys from the State Department of Agriculture under a past appropriation to use the moneys to pay expenses incurred in administering grasshopper suppression efforts.

HB 3527 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Public Drinking Water and Sewer Ratepayer Assistance Fund.

HB 3910

Expands the justifications for a domestic water supply district to exercise the powers of a sanitary district.

HB 2403

Authorizes landowners who meet certain criteria to petition for formation of a predator damage control district as a funding mechanism to pay the actual costs to the county of preventing, reducing and mitigating damage to property from predatory animals.

HB 3596 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to study mule deer in the Steens Mountain herd range area.
