Work Session

HB 2403

Authorizes landowners who meet certain criteria to petition for formation of a predator damage control district as a funding mechanism to pay the actual costs to the county of preventing, reducing and mitigating damage to property from predatory animals.

HB 3372

Directs the Water Resources Department to study exempt uses of water.

HB 3858

Makes remainder lands created by the lawful carve-out of lands by a recorded instrument into lawful units of land.

HB 2557

Prohibits a person from raising octopus for the purpose of human consumption or participating in the sale or offer for sale of octopus that was raised for human consumption.

HB 3596 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to study mule deer in the Steens Mountain herd range area.

HB 2801

Allows the Water Resources Department to approve leases or temporary transfers of certain water rights in the Upper Klamath Basin until a court issues a final water rights decree.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3862

Requires the Department of Land Conservation and Development to study land use and submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to land use no later than September 15, 2026.

HB 3827

Prohibits an individual from using a gillnet to land salmon in the main stem of the Columbia River.

HB 3901

Directs the Water Resources Department to study rules related to water.
