Work Session

SB 733

Expands the definition of the term "potentially dangerous dog," for dog control purposes, to include a dog that inflicts serious injury on or kills livestock.

SB 812

Repeals a sunset to make the landowner preference program permanent.

SB 817

Increases fees for filing a notice of intent to appeal and a motion to intervene with the Land Use Board of Appeals.

Public Hearing

SB 761 A

Authorizes the Water Resources Department to approve applications by certain water districts within the Walla Walla basin to lease existing water rights for temporary conversion to in-stream water rights if certain conditions exist and the department makes certain determinations.

SB 360

Creates a pesticide licensing exemption for certain employees using a battery-powered device to apply pesticides.
