Public Hearing

SB 904

Includes school districts among the self-insured employers that may apply for exemption from the rules requiring such employers to demonstrate financial viability and provide security to the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

SB 463 A

Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to submit by January 15 of each even-numbered year a report to the Legislative Assembly concerning the soundness of the state's Insurance Fund.

SB 831 A

Requires the person that has ultimate control over an insurer to file a group capital calculation with the chief insurance regulatory official of the state that the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services determines is the lead state for the insurance holding company system of which the insurer is a part.

Work Session

SB 854

Authorizes the Oregon Racing Commission to impose civil penalties for certain violations of animal racing law.

SB 855

Requires the Oregon Racing Commission to adopt rules establishing civil penalties for violation of laws, rules or directives relating to race meets.

SB 1176

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to conduct an effort to publicize and explain the obligation to accept cash as payment for goods and services to places of public accommodation and residents of this state.
