HB 3172 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of the State Fire Marshal to establish a grant program to facilitate the retrofitting of dwellings and accessory structures to reduce vulnerability to wildfire.

Directs the Public Utility Commission to provide for a classification of service for large energy use facilities.

HB3247

> Requires an electric company to first acquire a replacement resource of reliable or dispatchable electricity prior to retiring an electric power generating facility that provides reliable or dispatchable electricity.
