Work Session

HB 2566

Adds stand-alone energy resilience projects to the categories of projects eligible for a grant under the State Department of Energy's community renewable energy grant program.

HB 3172 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of the State Fire Marshal to establish a grant program to facilitate the retrofitting of dwellings and accessory structures to reduce vulnerability to wildfire.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3823 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Exempts from property taxes personal property used by a business to generate or store energy for consumption by the business on its premises.

Public Hearing

HB 2960

Prohibits the establishment or operation of a plastic conversion or depolymerization facility in this state.

HB 3814

Prohibits the Environmental Quality Commission and Department of Environmental Quality from requiring seafood processors to meet water quality or purity standards for bacteria in effluent discharges associated with fecal sources.

HB 3747 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Establishes a refundable income tax credit for the purchase of battery energy storage systems and solar photovoltaic electric systems.
