Public Hearing

SB 577

Requires an electric utility to recover costs for storing the waste produced by an energy facility in generating electricity.

Work Session

SB 75 A

Removes requirements related to wildfire hazards for purposes of developing an accessory dwelling unit on lands zoned for rural residential uses or a replacement dwelling on lands zoned for resource uses.

SB 85 A

Directs the Department of Consumer and Business Services and the Department of the State Fire Marshal, in consultation with the State Forestry Department and the insurance industry, to evaluate and develop recommendations for community-based wildfire risk mitigation to reduce wildfire risks and increase insurance affordability and availability.

SB 139 A

Permits sharps and waste pharmaceuticals to be consolidated in a single container, subject to certain requirements.

SB 685 A

Requires a natural gas utility to provide notice to each customer of the utility and the Public Utility Commission if the utility plans to increase the amount of hydrogen that the utility blends with natural gas and the ratio of the volume of hydrogen to the volume of natural gas will, for the first time, be greater than 2.

SB 551 A

Prohibits restaurants and retailers from providing single-use checkout bags to consumers.

SB 1067

Authorizes a city within Marion County to control or direct the disposal, transfer or material or energy recovery of solid waste generated within the city.
