SB75 A

> CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/15/2025 MEETING: Removes requirements related to wildfire hazards for purposes of developing an accessory dwelling unit on lands zoned for rural residential uses or a replacement dwelling on lands zoned for resource uses.

SB685 A

> CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/15/2025 MEETING: Requires a natural gas utility to provide notice to each customer of the utility and the Public Utility Commission if the utility plans to increase the amount of hydrogen that the utility blends with natural gas and the ratio of the volume of hydrogen to the volume of natural gas will, for the first time, be greater than 2.

SB1067

> CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/15/2025 MEETING: Authorizes a city within Marion County to control or direct the disposal, transfer or material or energy recovery of solid waste generated within the city.

SB 83 A

Eliminates certain building code standards and mapping requirements for wildfire hazard mitigation.

SB 577

Requires an electric utility to recover costs for storing the waste produced by an energy facility in generating electricity.

SB726 A

> Requires the owner or operator of a municipal solid waste landfill to conduct surface emissions monitoring and report data as specified in the Act.
