HB 2348

(8:00-8:05 am) Adjusts certain economic development program statutes related to the administration of the programs.

HB 2350 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(8:05-8:10 am) Directs the Oregon Business Development Department to develop and administer a program for awarding financial assistance for enhanced and new commercial activities that support the retention or expansion of eligible small businesses in Oregon.

Public Hearing

HB 2120

(8:10-8:40 am) Clarifies that a liquor store's amount of annual sales of alcoholic beverages used to determine liquor store class is not adjusted.

HB 2121

(8:40-9:10 am) Includes a liquor store agent appointed by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission in the definition of "licensee" for purposes of alcoholic beverages laws.

HB 2123

(9:10-9:30 am) Specifies the type of change in the system for selling containers of distilled liquor that qualifies a person appointed to operate a liquor store for business loss compensation.

Note change: HB 2348 and HB 2350 have been added.
