Work Session

- HB 3059 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Department of Human Services and the Department of Education to jointly study the needs of youth who are in a residential facility and who attend a public school in this state.
- HB 2907 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Creates an income tax credit for investment in community gardens and food banks.

Public Hearing

- HB 3224 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Department of Human Services to review the statutes of this state to identify all instances of required background checks, similarities and differences in the different background checks, and report on options to consolidate and reduce the number of different background checks for similar purposes or programs.
- HB 3560
Expands areas where a child care facility may be sited.
