HB 2150

Requires the Department of Human Services to study the recommendations from the rate and wage study.

HB 2374 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Parenting Effectiveness Program within the Department of Human Services.

HB 3733 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Clackamas County Children’s Commission for a Head Start facility.

Work Session

HB 2814

Authorizes the Department of Early Learning and Care to waive certain requirements for certified child care facilities upon good cause shown and if the resulting circumstances protect the welfare of the children and the consumer interests of the parents of the children.

HB 3496

Requires the Department of Land Conservation and Development to develop guidance for local governments on siting, and incentivizing the development of, child care facilities on or before December 31, 2026.

HB 2976 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to nonprofit groups for purposes related to interpretation of indigenous languages.
