**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to be used for funding outreach regarding federal earned income tax credits and other tax benefits and to provide tax navigation and preparation to low-income individuals.

HB 3933 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Early Learning and Care for the purpose of funding Relief Nursery programs.

HB 2374 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Parenting Effectiveness Program within the Department of Human Services.

HB 3560

Expands areas where a child care facility may be sited.

HB 2452 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of Early Learning and Care to establish a program to award grants to child care resource and referral entities to help parents or guardians of children access child care.

HB 3497 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires specified agencies to consider the effects of a proposed action on older adult populations.

HB 2061 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes a task force on the recruitment and retention of case managers and adult protective services workers.
