Work Session

HB 3496

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-27-2025 MEETING Requires the Department of Land Conservation and Development to develop guidance for local governments on siting, and incentivizing the development of, child care facilities on or before December 31, 2026.

Possible Work Session

HB 3560

Expands areas where a child care facility may be sited.

HB 2452 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of Early Learning and Care to establish a program to award grants to child care resource and referral entities to help parents or guardians of children access child care.

HB 3497 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires specified agencies to consider the effects of a proposed action on older adult populations.

Public Hearing

HB 2061 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes a task force on the recruitment and retention of case managers and adult protective services workers.

HB 2956

Requires the Department of Human Services to study adult foster homes.

HB 2924

Modifies the number and description of members on the System of Care Advisory Council.
