HB 2924

Modifies the number and description of members on the System of Care Advisory Council.

HB 3201 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of Education to implement policies and procedures that increase access to healthy and culturally-relevant food for children in child care.

HB 3224 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Department of Human Services to review the statutes of this state to identify all instances of required background checks, similarities and differences in the different background checks, and report on options to consolidate and reduce the number of different background checks for similar purposes or programs.

HB 3079 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Department of Human Services to update its 2022 estimate of costs to implement youth experiencing homelessness programs.

HB 2593 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Department of Early Learning and Care to study the impact on student parents and working parents of the waitlist to participate in the Employment Related Day Care subsidy program.

HB 3835

Modifies provisions regarding the use of restraint and involuntary seclusion on certain young people.

Public Hearing

HB 3795

Requires the Department of Human Services to study human services.

HB 3796

Requires the Department of Early Learning and Care to study early childhood.

HB 3797

Requires the Department of Human Services to study the demographics of children in Oregon.
