HB 2924

Modifies the number and description of members on the System of Care Advisory Council.

HB 3933 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-1-2025 MEETING. Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Early Learning and Care for the purpose of funding Relief Nursery programs.

HB 2452 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-1-2025 MEETING. Directs the Department of Early Learning and Care to establish a program to award grants to child care resource and referral entities to help parents or guardians of children access child care.

HB 2991 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-1-2025 MEETING. Appropriates moneys to be used for funding outreach regarding federal earned income tax credits and other tax benefits and to provide tax navigation and preparation to low-income individuals.

HB 3795

Requires the Department of Human Services to study human services.

HB 3201 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of Education to implement policies and procedures that increase access to healthy and culturally-relevant food for children in child care.

HB 3224 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Department of Human Services to review the statutes of this state to identify all instances of required background checks, similarities and differences in the different background checks, and report on options to consolidate and reduce the number of different background checks for similar purposes or programs.

HB 2593 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Department of Early Learning and Care to study the impact on student parents and working parents of the waitlist to participate in the Employment Related Day Care subsidy program.

Modifies provisions regarding the use of restraint and involuntary seclusion on certain young people.
