- HB 3079 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Department of Human Services to update its 2022 estimate of costs to implement youth experiencing homelessness programs.
- HB 2061 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes a task force on the recruitment and retention of case managers and adult protective services workers.
- HB 2150
Requires the Department of Human Services to study the recommendations from the rate and wage study.
- HB 2452 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2025 MEETING. Directs the Department of Early Learning and Care to establish a program to award grants to child care resource and referral entities to help parents or guardians of children access child care.
- HB 3201 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2025 MEETING. Directs the Department of Education to implement policies and procedures that increase access to healthy and culturally-relevant food for children in child care.
- HB 2593 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-3-2025 MEETING. Requires the Department of Early Learning and Care to study the impact on student parents and working parents of the waitlist to participate in the Employment Related Day Care subsidy program.
