Public Hearing

SB 944

Modifies independent living requirements for older foster children.

SB 1016 A

Directs the Department of Human Services to maintain an inventory of appropriate carriers for the transportation of a foster child's personal belongings.

SB 875 A

Modifies the Oregon Foster Children's Bill of Rights and the Oregon Foster Children's Sibling Bill of Rights.

SB 465 A

Removes the annual cap on matching funds that an individual development account holder may accrue.
