SB 810

Directs the Department of Human Services to collaborate with the Department of Education to increase opportunities for individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities to obtain and advance in competitive integrated employment.

SB 1099

Requires cities and counties to allow lands where worship is allowed to be used for preschool.

SB 228 A

Establishes the right of a resident of a residential care facility to organize and participate in resident groups, including an independent family council.
