Public Hearing

- HB 2684 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires that a school integrated pest management plan and low-impact pesticide list be reviewed at least once every five years and made available to the public on a website.
- HB 2307
Exempts, until January 2, 2030, lamps purchased by a school district from the prohibition on the sale of certain fluorescent lamps.
- HB 2941 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Department of Education to provide technical assistance to school districts to plan and develop certain projects eligible for federal tax credits.

Possible Work Session

- HB 2953 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue then to Ways and Means
Removes the percentage cap on the amount of moneys that are distributed from the State School Fund to school districts for students eligible for special education as a child with a disability.
- HB 2682 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Department of Education to establish an advisory committee to study and develop recommendations to modernize the adequate service levels for early intervention and early childhood special education in this state.
- HB 2448 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Increases the amount of money transferred each fiscal year by the Department of Education from the State School Fund to the High Cost Disabilities Account.
