#### Work Session

- HB 2684 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires that a school integrated pest management plan and low-impact pesticide list be reviewed at least once every five years and made available to the public on a website.
- HB 2941 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires the Department of Education to provide technical assistance to school districts to plan and develop certain projects eligible for federal tax credits.
- HB 3218 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires the Commission on Indian Services and the Department of Education to study the Tribal Attendance Promising Practices grant program.
- HB 3014 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes the School District Facility Equity Fund.
- HB 2423 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes the Task Force on Licensed Health Care Services in Oregon Schools.
- HB 2007 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Modifies requirements for the summer learning program.

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Education for career and technical student organization grants and for activities related to career and technical education that can lead to high wage and high demand jobs.
- HB 2529 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Prescribes requirements for a cardiac emergency response plan for each school.

HB 3004 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the Youth Development Division to establish a statewide community violence prevention program.

HB 3562 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs schools to prepare school maps for use by local and state public safety agencies responsible for emergency services at the school.
