Work Session

- HB 3014 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the School District Facility Equity Fund.
- HB 3037 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Allows the State Board of Education to establish for small school districts a minimum grant amount and the Department of Education to reduce the administrative burden related to applying for and reporting on grants.
- HB 3652
Expands the requirement to discuss class size and caseload as mandatory subjects of bargaining for purposes of school district collective bargaining.

Public Hearing

- HB 2251
Directs school districts to adopt a policy that prohibits the use of student personal electronic devices.
- HB 2359 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires school districts and public charter schools to implement a schedule for high schools that does not start regular instructional hours before 8:30 a.
- HB 2673 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the Department of Education to establish an accreditation program for school business professionals.
- HB 3149 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Allows for additional distributions of state moneys to wildfire-impacted school districts for an additional four school years.

HB 3373

Directs the Department of Education to prepare and distribute a report that compiles the audit findings for school districts, education service districts and public charter schools.
