HB 3175

Removes the cap on fees a county may charge to fund the county's activities related to public land survey corners.

Defines "honorable conditions" as related to the discharge or release of a veteran.

HB 2995 ** *Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes the Task Force on Reparations and directs the task force to study and develop proposals for financial and nonfinancial reparations for Oregonians of African-American descent, develop appropriate methods for educating the public about the task force's findings and recommend appropriate remedies based on the task force's findings.
