HB 2693 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/11/2025 MEETING: Authorizes the issuance of lottery bonds for deposit in the Levee Project Grant Fund.

HB 2726 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/11/2025 MEETING: Authorizes the issuance of lottery bonds to fund Columbia corridor flood safety projects in Multnomah County.

HCR 23  
Recognizes and honors Oregon civilians who served the United States on Wake Island during World War II. Commends individuals who have increased public awareness of the service and sacrifice of these civilians.

**Public Hearing**

HB 2200 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the Oregon Investment Council and the State Treasurer to take certain actions to reduce the carbon intensity of state investments and address certain investment risks relating to climate change.

HB 3460 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the Oregon Health Authority to administer a program to reimburse the cost of hyperbaric oxygen therapy for low-income veterans who have been diagnosed with traumatic brain injury or post-traumatic stress disorder and are ineligible for medical assistance.

HB 3492 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to study risks and issues relating to earthquake-induced dispersion of hazardous materials.
