HB 2669 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires community colleges to pay part-time faculty at the same rate, on a per-hour basis, as the community college pays full-time faculty to prepare for and teach a course.

Public Hearing

HB 2405 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections for distribution to some department institutions in eastern Oregon for the purpose of providing educational programs to adults in custody.

HB 2719 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Guaranteed Opportunity Program.

HB 3571 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to Oregon State University for purposes of the Institute for Water and Watersheds.

HB 3634 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Water Workforce Program in the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to support workforce development initiatives within the water workforce.

HB 3700
Directs the Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule standards for certification of sewage treatment works operators from nonreciprocal states, provinces or other certifying entities.
