Work Session

- HB 2997 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish a grant program for the purpose of supporting organizations to expand the scope and community reach of college access and success programs.
- HB 3109 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to the Sustainable City Year Program at the University of Oregon.
- HB 3182 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to administer a grant program to fund basic needs programming.
- HB 3183 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for purposes of the Open Educational Resources Program.
- HB 3185 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Provides that priority may be given to students in specified courses of study to participate in a pilot program to enhance the hiring of public university students by eligible nonprofit organizations.
- HB 3066 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections for purpose of funding the advanced esthetics program at the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility.
- HB 3618 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to Southwestern Oregon Community College to repair elevators in Tioga Hall.

Public Hearing

- HB 2539 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to develop a plan for enabling community colleges to offer an associate's degree completed in coordination with credits earned in an apprenticeship or training program.
- HB 3731
Provides additional data to be included by institutions of higher education in an annual report regarding allegations of sexual misconduct and violence on the campus of the institution.
- HB 3826 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes a program within the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to promote workforce development initiatives in the trucking industry.
