#### Work Session

HB 2421

Includes independent institutions in the direct admissions program established by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

HB 2747 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Department of Corrections to provide adults in custody at all department institutions access to specific online educational programs.

HB 3109 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to the Sustainable City Year Program at the University of Oregon.

HB 3635 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases the limit on the aggregate amount of XI-G general obligation bonds that may be issued for projects at a single community college.

#### Public Hearing

HB 3534 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides for a waiver of tuition, fees and the cost of textbooks for veterans and the children of veterans from eligible post-secondary institutions.

HB 3694

Modifies provisions of law related to compensation for student athletes enrolled in a post-secondary institution of education.

HB 3809

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Housing and Community Services Department for the individual development account program.

HB 3920

Increases the age limit for tuition waivers for qualified students.
