HB 2458 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct a study on reporting requirements placed on public universities in this state.

HB 2695

Requires the Oregon Health and Science University Board of Directors to include specified individuals in the search and hiring committees for a president of the university.

#### HB 2686 \*\*

**\*\***Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Provides funding to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for purposes of providing a grant to an organization that manages a statewide strategy to re-enroll residents of this state into certain programs.

HB 3053 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be distributed to the University of Oregon for purposes of a pilot program training graduate-level students who are learning to become speech-language pathologists to use a family-centered approach when serving children with augmentative and alternative communication needs in a traditional overnight summer camp setting.

3634 \*\* HB \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes the Water Workforce Program in the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to support workforce development initiatives within the water workforce.

#### **Public Hearing**

HB 3006 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Education for various purposes related to increasing the representation of marginalized populations in the education workforce in this state.

#### HB 3026

Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to study higher education.

HB 3030 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to award grants to culturally and linguistically diverse school administrator candidates to use at approved educator preparation programs.
