HB 2405 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections for distribution to some department institutions in eastern Oregon for the purpose of providing educational programs to adults in custody.

HB 2649

Permits certain public universities in this state to increase tuition and fees without the approval of the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

HB 3006 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Education for various purposes related to increasing the representation of marginalized populations in the education workforce in this state.

HB 3008 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys to fund child care workforce investments.

HB 3026

Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to study higher education.

HB 3029 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Makes changes to workforce development statutes to improve alignment across workforce development programs and projects.

3030 ** HB **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Authorizes the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to award grants to culturally and linguistically diverse school administrator candidates to use at approved educator preparation programs.

HB 3213

Requires that public university foundations are subject to the public records laws of this state. HB 3552

Allows education service districts to establish regional career centers to provide career and technical education.
