Public Hearing

- HB 2935 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study pretrial release and include certain data in the study.
- HB 2302
Modifies the definition of "vulnerable person" for purposes of civil action for abuse of a vulnerable person to include individuals under 18 years of age.

Work Session

- HB 2464
Makes nonsubstantive and technical changes in Oregon law.

The following bill is scheduled solely for the purpose of moving it to the House Higher Education and Workforce Development Committee.

- HB 2747 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Department of Corrections to provide adults in custody at all department institutions access to specific online educational programs.
