Public Hearing

HB 3194

Establishes that landowners and persons acting as farmworker camp operators are jointly and severally liable for operating a farmworker camp on the landowner's property unless certain conditions are met.

Work Session

HB 2461

Changes notice requirements and requirements related to facilities and technology for motions to allow remote location testimony.

HB 2819

Authorizes persons who enforce fire protection laws to issue citations if there are reasonable grounds to believe violations have occurred.

HB 3347

Directs the Department of Justice to disburse to certain obligees payments of support that have been assigned to the state.
