Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2183

Directs the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to adopt rules providing that, if an applicant for certification as a private security professional is or was certified as a police officer, a refresher course and examination satisfies the training requirements for certification.

HB 3766

Allows a plaintiff to bring a civil action against a person who transmits an intimate image to the plaintiff's computer or electronic device in certain circumstances.

HB 3819

Allows the State Board of Massage Therapists to issue a registration to practice reflexology to a qualified applicant.

HB 2055

Provides that when offering a service with age restrictions, a private entity is allowed to swipe a driver's license to verify a person's age, regardless of how old the person looks.

HB 2613

Requires the Department of Human Services to study how to improve services provided to victims of child abuse in this state.

HB 3180 **

Appropriates moneys to the Judicial Department for the Washington County Courthouse Replacement Planning Project.

HB 3347

Directs the Department of Justice to disburse to certain obligees payments of support that have been assigned to the state.
