Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2306

Allows the Marion County board of county commissioners to establish a justice of the peace district that includes the county seat.

HB 3582

Eliminates the statute of limitations for civil actions based on sexual assault or child sexual abuse.

HB 3819

Allows the State Board of Massage Therapists to issue a registration to practice reflexology to a qualified applicant.

Work Session

HB 2668

Requires certain private persons, before engaging in search and rescue efforts, to make specified disclosures to the family of the missing person and to notify county sheriffs.

HB 3118

Requires the Department of Corrections to enter into a contract with a third party to provide communications services at no cost to persons confined at a Department of Corrections institution.

HB 3174

Increases the fee paid for alcohol and drug screening specialists.

HB 3080

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/25/2025 MEETING: Modifies provisions regarding who can act as a health care representative for an incapacitated person who has not appointed a health care representative or does not have an advance directive.

HB 3093 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/25/2025 MEETING: Requires law enforcement agencies to take a DNA sample of a person arrested for certain crimes.

HB 3929

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/25/2025 MEETING: Establishes a testimonial privilege for communications by certain public safety employees to a peer supporter.
