#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2311

Provides that the Oregon Health Authority is not required to use administrative law judges from the Office of Administrative Hearings for contested case hearings involving the Oregon State Hospital.

HB 2470 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to expand the capacity of the Oregon State Hospital.

HB 2476

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to study issues related to fitness to proceed and to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2026.

HB 2480

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study behavioral health.

HB 3051

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to study fitness to proceed and requires the authority to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than May 1, 2026.

#### Work Session

HB 2306

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/26/2025 MEETING: Allows the Marion County board of county commissioners to establish a justice of the peace district that includes the county seat.

HB 3582

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/26/2025 MEETING: Eliminates the statute of limitations for civil actions based on sexual assault or child sexual abuse.

HB 3819

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/26/2025 MEETING: Allows the State Board of Massage Therapists to issue a registration to practice reflexology to a qualified applicant.

HB 2668

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/26/2025 MEETING: Requires certain private persons, before engaging in search and rescue efforts, to make specified disclosures to the family of the missing person and to notify county sheriffs.

HB 3174

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/26/2025 MEETING: Increases the fee paid for alcohol and drug screening specialists.
