HB 2473 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Modifies the requirements for providing a declaration for the purposes of authenticating records in response to criminal process. 2522 ** HB **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires the use of headlights when the windshield wipers are on or there is fog. HB 2641 Modifies when a prior conviction is admissible to impeach the character of a witness. HB 2712 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Provides that the Judicial Department may implement an audit schedule for the circuit courts. HB 2975 Provides that an admission or a finding that a crime constitutes domestic violence is not an element of the crime for merger purposes. HB 3097 Increases sentencing guidelines for felony attempting to elude a police officer. HB 2639 Modifies the process for setting aside convictions, dismissals, contempt of court findings and guilty except for insanity judgments.
