**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes a time limit on when a district attorney may submit an indictment to the grand jury on a pending case when a trial date has been scheduled.

HB 2639

Modifies the process for setting aside convictions, dismissals, contempt of court findings and guilty except for insanity judgments.

HB 2641

Modifies when a prior conviction is admissible to impeach the character of a witness.

2712 ** HB

Provides that the Judicial Department may implement an audit schedule for the circuit courts. 3097 HB

Increases sentencing guidelines for felony attempting to elude a police officer.

Work Session

HB 2306

Allows the Marion County board of county commissioners to establish a justice of the peace district that includes the county seat.

HB 2471

Modifies when a person is guilty except for insanity.

HB 2473 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Modifies the requirements for providing a declaration for the purposes of authenticating records in response to criminal process.

HB 2522 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires the use of headlights when the windshield wipers are on or there is fog. HB 2555

Changes the name of the Family Sentencing Alternative Pilot Program to the Family Sentencing Alternative Program.

HB 2975

Provides that an admission or a finding that a crime constitutes domestic violence is not an element of the crime for merger purposes.

HB 3174

Increases the fee paid for alcohol and drug screening specialists.

HB 3582

Eliminates the statute of limitations for civil actions based on sexual assault or child sexual abuse.

Note change: HB 2306, HB 3174, and HB 3582 have been added.
