Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2492

Requires the State Court Administrator to study courts and submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary not later than September 15, 2026.

HB 2605

Requires the State Court Administrator to study fees and submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary not later than September 15, 2026.

HB 3067 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study repealing the sunset of the Justice Reinvestment Program.

HB 3069

Requires the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to study public safety.

HB 3825

Shortens the time period after which judgment remedies for monetary obligations in criminal judgments without restitution expire.

Work Session

HB 2851

Modifies the definition of "critical infrastructure" to include a terrestrial-based cable or wire communication facility for purposes of the crimes of domestic terrorism in the first degree and domestic terrorism in the second degree.

HB 3075

Modifies the firearm permit provisions of Ballot Measure 114 (2022).

HB 3076 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of Justice to study the establishment of a state gun dealer licensing program, and to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2026.
