Public Hearing

SB 277

Allows a law enforcement agency or public body to provide information, or enter into an agreement to provide information, as required to effect an international extradition and return of a person charged with or convicted of a crime in this state and for whom a warrant of arrest has been issued.

SB 710 A

Modifies the enumerated authority of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to include the authority to establish continuing education requirements for state court judges.

SB 993

Authorizes law enforcement agencies to release booking photos to licensed private investigators.

SJM 2

Urges Congress to enact legislation alleviating the funding crisis in the Crime Victims Fund.
