#### Work Session

SB 15 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Expands the types of estates that may use the simple estate process to administer a decedent's estate.

SB 170 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Increases the offense level of assault in the fourth degree when the defendant commits the assault against a victim performing official duties as part of the victim's employment and has certain prior convictions for assault in the workplace.

SB 233 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Allows a person to file an action to recover damages for injuries arising from or in connection with removal of a hernia mesh that occurred on or after January 1, 2018, and before January 1, 2019.

SB 238 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Modifies provisions relating to the use of unmanned aircraft systems by law enforcement officers and agencies.

SB 275 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Modifies the Organized Retail Theft Grant Program.

SB 385 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Modifies the offense of making a false report of child abuse.

SB 473 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Creates the crime of threatening a public official.

SB 926 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Prohibits the recovery from customers of certain costs and expenses that an electric company incurs if a court or jury finds that a wildfire resulted from the negligence or a higher degree of fault on the part of the electric company.

SB 1121 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Creates the crime of unlawful disclosure of private information.

SB 1125 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/2025 MEETING: Increases the penalties for using an unmanned aircraft system to interfere with a wildfire suppression effort.
