#### Public Hearing

HB 2541

Provides certain agricultural workers with rights to express breast milk in the workplace.

HB 3881

Adds school districts, education service districts and public charter schools to the definition of "qualifying agency" for the purpose of applying apprenticeship requirements in connection with constructing public improvement projects.

#### Work Session

HB 2248

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study matters relating to laws over which the bureau has enforcement authority.

HB 2972 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides funding to the Employment Department for staffing workforce reentry programs for adults in custody.

HB 2957

Prohibits employers from entering into agreements that shorten the statute of limitations with respect to violations over which the Bureau of Labor and Industries has enforcement authority.

HB 3193 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to establish and implement a permanent farmworker disaster relief program.

HB 3550

Exempts from certain laws governing certain employment conditions minor league baseball players who are subject to a collective bargaining agreement that provides for payment of wages and other working conditions.
