Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2236

Directs the Director of the Employment Department to reimburse a worker leasing company for any employer contribution payments made by the worker leasing company if the Department of Revenue determines pursuant to an amended combined quarterly report that a refund is due.

Work Session

HB 2125

Authorizes the Director of the Employment Department to waive the unpaid waiting week period for unemployment insurance claimants who are unable to perform services due a state-declared emergency related to severe weather.

HB 2799

Removes the cap on reasonable litigation costs and expenses and attorney fees for a claimant who prevails in a workers' compensation dispute.

HB 2800

Changes the term "worker leasing company" to "professional employer organization" in statute to reflect the use of PEOs by businesses to coemploy workers.

HB 3860

Prohibits a major residential contractor from collecting or retaining more than 50 percent of the original contract price before substantially completing a remodeling or repair of an owner-occupied one-family or two-family residential structure if the original contract price exceeds \$40,000.

Note change: a work session on HB 3860 has been added.
