Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2020

Requires that qualified nonprofit agencies for individuals with disabilities employ individuals with disabilities for not less than 50 percent of the work hours of direct labor required for manufacturing or providing products or services.

Work Session

HB 2236

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/31/25 MEETING: Directs the Director of the Employment Department to reimburse a worker leasing company for any employer contribution payments made by the worker leasing company if the Department of Revenue determines pursuant to an amended combined quarterly report that a refund is due.

HB 2688

Applies the prevailing rate of wage to certain off-site custom work fabricated, assembled or produced in accordance with specifications for a particular public works.

HB 2944

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/31/25 MEETING: Permits a labor organization to file a civil action against a public employer for failing to timely provide the labor organization with certain information regarding public employees.

HB 3187

Clarifies the meaning of "because of age" for purposes of employment discrimination law.

Note change: work sessions for HB 2799, HB 2540, HB 3838, and HB 3881 have been removed.
